Introduction

The INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE SHARING AND LEARNING FOR MENTORING IN EDUCATION - ICSLME 2023 is organized by the Romanian Ministry of Education in the framework of the strategic project on developing the teaching career - "Profesionalizarea carierei didactice - PROF" - project ID: POCU/904/6/25/146587) in partnership with the "Lucian Blaga" University of Sibiu, Transilvania University of Braşov, "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati, "George Emil Palade" University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Sciences and Technology of Târgu Mureş.
